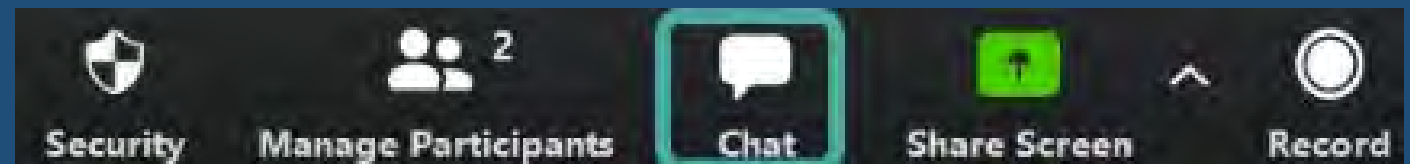
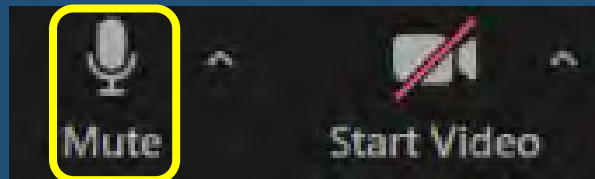

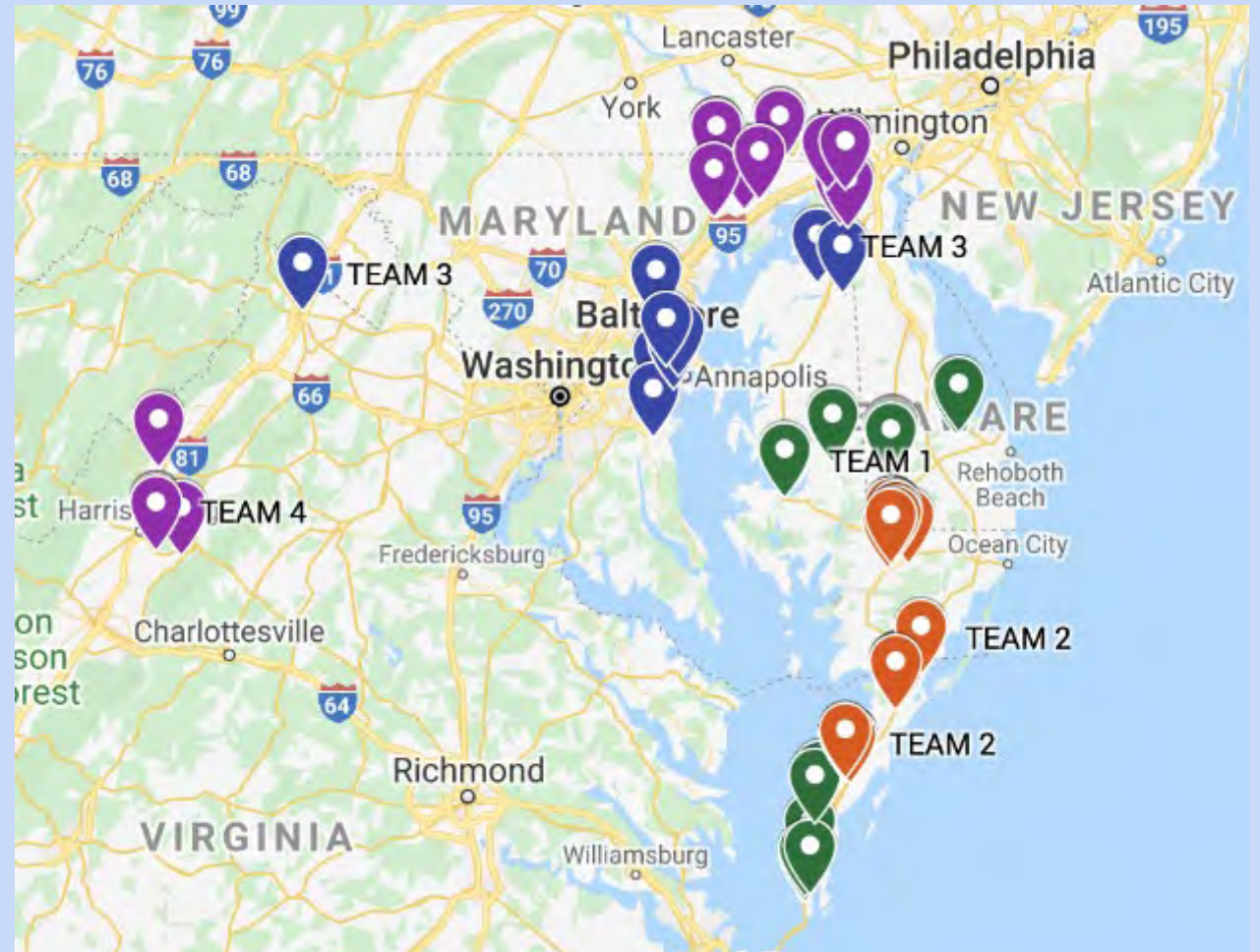

Vaccine Approval roadmap



IND Submitted

Before Clinical Studies/Trials are conducted, the Investigational New Drug Application (IND by its acronym in English) is submitted to the FDA.

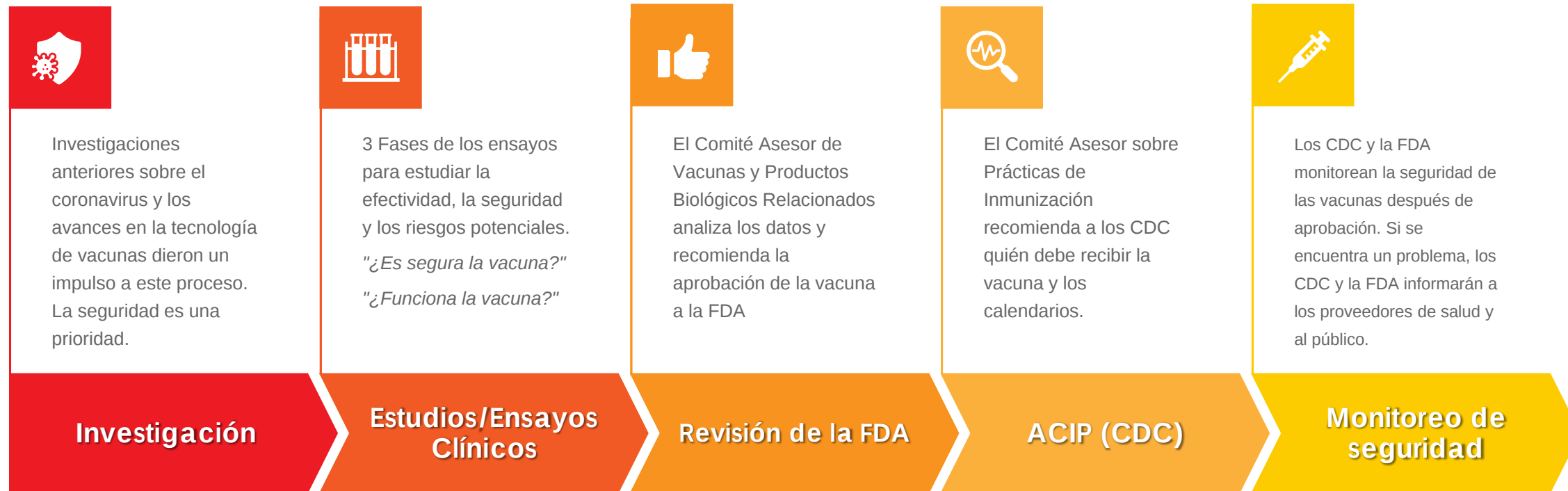
BLA Submitted

If the clinical trials demonstrate that the vaccine is safe and effective, the manufacturer submits a Biologics License Application (BLA by its acronym in English) to FDA requesting two licenses: one for the vaccine and one for the production plant

ACIP Recommendation

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP by its acronym in English) is a group of medical and public health experts. ACIP provides advice and guidance to the Director of the CDC.

Effectiveness of the different vaccines

Efectividad de las diferentes vacunas

- All approved vaccines in US prevent severe illness, hospitalizations and death
- Waning immunity, but still very effective
 - In some people, particularly elderly
 - After 6 months
- Todas las vacunas aprobadas en Estados Unidos previenen enfermedades graves, hospitalizaciones y muertes
- Disminuye la inmunidad, pero aún así muy efectiva
 - En algunas personas, particularmente en ancianos
 - Después de 6 meses

Additional Doses / Booster

Dosis adicionales / Refuerzo

- Pfizer booster and Moderna (1/2 dose of original) currently available 6 months after 2nd dose
 - 65 years +
 - Certain occupations
 - 18 -65 – underlying medical conditions
- Johnson & Johnson
 - 2 months after 1st dose for 18 years +
- Refuerzo de Pfizer y Moderna (1/2 dosis del original) actualmente disponibles 6 meses después de la 2^a dosis
 - 65 años +
 - Ciertas ocupaciones
 - 18 -65 – condiciones médicas subyacentes
- Johnson & Johnson
 - 2 meses después de la primera dosis para mayores de 18 años

Mixing and Matching

Mezcla y combinación

- Mixing and Matching approved
 - Recommendations:
 - For Pfizer and Moderna avoid mixing, if possible
 - But fine to mix brands if unavailable
 - Second dose for Johnson & Johnson- any vaccine?
- Mezcla y combinaciones aprobadas
 - Recomendaciones:
 - Con Pfizer y Moderna eviten la mezcla, si es posible
 - Pero está bien mezclar marcas si no está disponible
 - Segunda dosis para Johnson & Johnson, ¿alguna vacuna?

Kids (Age 5-11)

Niños (de 5 a 11 años)

- Biden administration is preparing to administer Pfizer vaccines to kids
 - Found to be safe and effective
 - FDA's independent advisory committee meets Oct. 26
 - CDC's independent advisory committee meets Nov. 2 and 3
- La administración Biden se prepara para administrar vacunas de Pfizer a niños
 - Se ha encontrado que es seguro y efectivo
 - El comité asesor independiente de la FDA se reúne el 26 de octubre
 - El comité asesor independiente de los CDC se reúne el 2 y 3 de noviembre

Is the vaccine safe for me and my baby? What has changed over time?

- Early in the pandemic, we didn't know the effects of the vaccine on pregnant women and their babies.
- Now, we have lots of data, and we can confidently say: **the COVID-19 vaccines are very safe for you and your baby!**
- As of late August 2021, more than **139,000 pregnant women have been vaccinated against COVID-19.**
- There have been no reports of any increased risk of pregnancy loss, growth problems, or birth defects.
- COVID-19 vaccines are not live vaccines, and pregnant women and their babies cannot get COVID-19 from the vaccine.

In fact, the real risk is when a pregnant woman chooses NOT to get vaccinated.

Women who become ill with COVID-19 during pregnancy:

- Are 3 times more likely to need ICU care
- Are 2 to 3 times more likely to need advanced life support and a breathing tube
- Have a small increased risk of dying from COVID-19
- Are at an increased risk of having a stillbirth and preterm birth

HOW DO I GET A COVID-19 VACCINE?

- ✓ **Contact your local health department to make an appointment or ask them where mobile vaccine clinics are located.**
- ✓ **Talk to your OB/GYN.**
- ✓ **Check with your local pharmacy. They will likely offer vaccines.**
- ✓ **Contact your local community health center to make an appointment.**
- ✓ **Speak with your employer about getting a COVID-19 vaccine. They may be helpful in making arrangements to get a vaccine.**

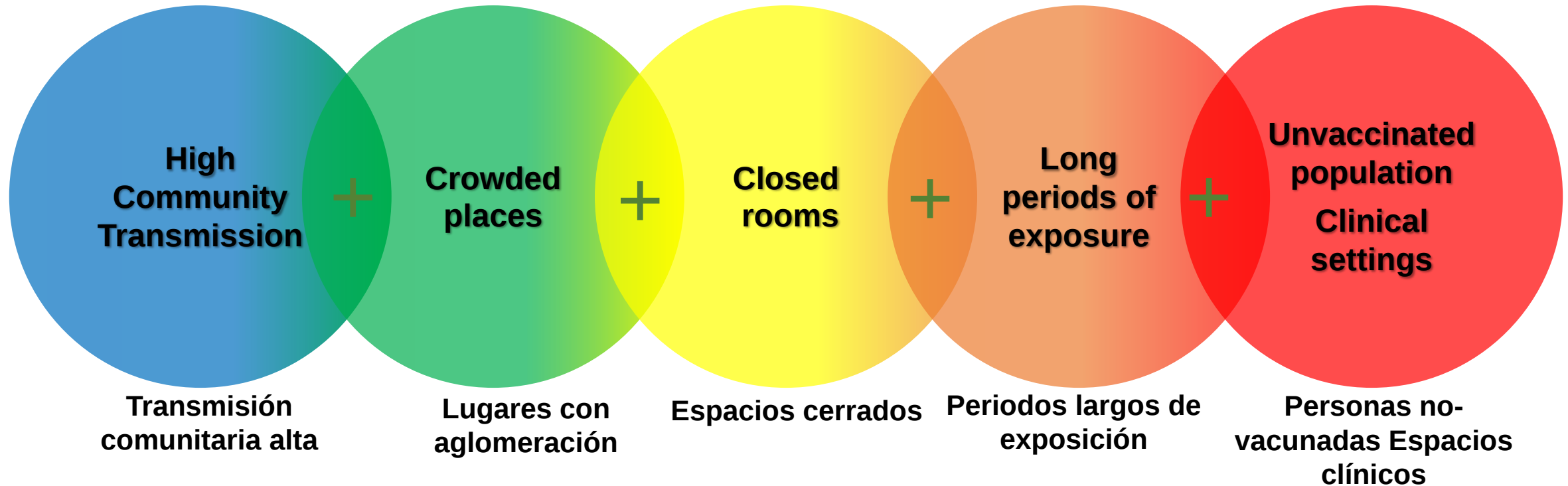

How do I use it properly?

Before | Antes

Wash hands, review condition, hold by ear loops or ties, check if it is well adjusted

During | Durante

Over mouth and nose. Do not touch. Remove for eating/drinking

Sobre boca y nariz. No tocar. Retirar para comer / beber



After | Después

Wash hands, clean and/or storage

How long can I use a respirator or mask? How to clean and maintain it?

- Disposable masks: Dispose carefully in trash after one use.
- Surgical masks: Dispose carefully after one use.
- Cloth mask: Clean after use.
 - Soap and water (can be done with regular laundry)
 - Sun dry or other.
 - Long use periods: review fit and dispose if it not longer holds or if broken.
- Respirator:
 - Usually disposable after one use.
 - Can last longer if (around a week):
 - It is alternated with other masks
 - We allow it to dry
 - Fit still works

¿Por cuánto tiempo puedo utilizar un respirador o mascarilla? ¿Cómo limpiarla y mantenerla?

- Mascarillas desechables: Deseche con cuidado en la basura después de un uso.
- Mascarillas quirúrgicas: Desechar con cuidado después de un uso.
- Mascarilla de tela: Limpiar después de su uso.
 - Agua y jabón (se puede lavar con ropa normal)
 - Secar al sol u otro.
 - Períodos de uso prolongados: revise el ajuste y deséchelo si ya no se sostiene o si está roto.
- Respirador:
 - Generalmente desechable después de un uso.
 - Puede durar más si (alrededor de una semana):
 - Se alterna con otras máscaras.
 - Dejamos que se seque
 - Ajuste todavía funciona

Can wearing a mask or respirator affect my health?

¿Usar la mascarilla o respirador puede afectarme la salud?

- Oxygen and CO₂ are very small compared to droplets, so they can easily pass through a face mask.
- The effects of wearing masks are minimal at most even in people with very severe lung impairment.
- El oxígeno y el CO₂ son muy pequeños en comparación con las gotas, por lo que pueden pasar fácilmente a través de una mascarilla.
- Los efectos del uso de máscaras son mínimos como máximo incluso en personas con insuficiencia pulmonar muy grave.

What rules are there about the use of respirators?

¿Qué reglas existen sobre el uso de respiradores?

- It is **required** for people exposed to patients in clinical procedures
 - It is **recommended** for workers with high levels of exposure to unvaccinated populations or patients with suspected COVID-19.
 - It is **optional** for the rest of the population.
- Es **requerido** para personas expuestas a pacientes en procedimientos clínicos
 - Es **recomendado** para trabajadores con altos niveles de exposición a poblaciones no vacunadas o pacientes con sospecha de COVID-19.
 - Es **opcional** para el resto de la población.

What rules are there about the use of respirators?

¿Qué reglas existen sobre el uso de respiradores?

- If as an employer, you **require** the use of respirators you must:
 - Have a respiratory protection program.
 - Train workers.
 - Do fit testing.
 - Provide respirator.
- If, as an employer, you **provide or allow** the use of respirators, you must:
 - Complete Appendix D of OSHA Sec. 1910.134
- Si como empleador, **requieres** el uso de respiradores debes:
 - Tener un programa de protección respiratoria.
 - Adiestrar a los trabajadores.
 - Hacer pruebas de ajuste.
 - Proveer el respirador.
- Si como empleador, **provees o permites** el uso de respiradores debes:
 - Completar apéndice D de Sec. 1910.134 de OSHA

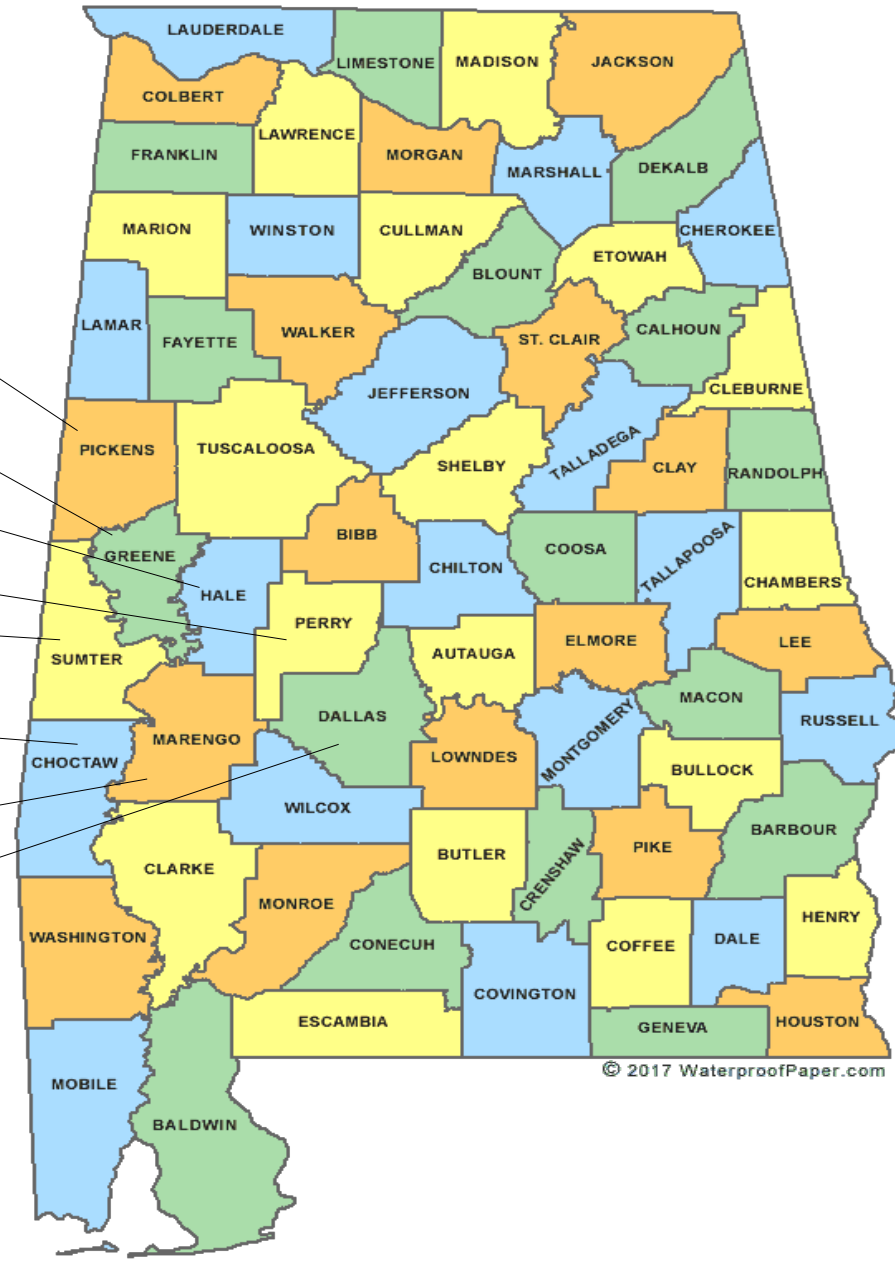

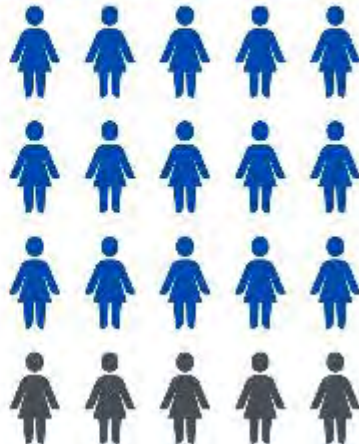

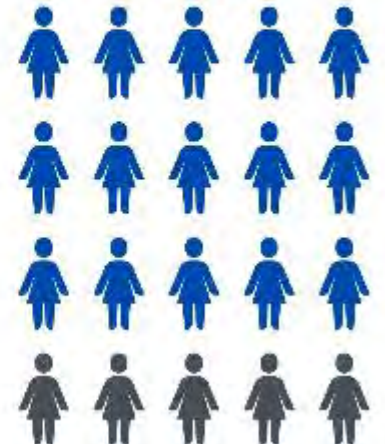

Migrant Clinicians Network continues to receive questions from our clinical network on COVID-19 vaccines for their migrant, immigrant, and farmworker communities. While vaccines are available for all in the US, ages 12 and up, in reality, COVID-19 vaccines remain inaccessible for many people, for a variety of reasons, including fear over immigration status and misinformation. The dynamic situation does not belie the underlying mantra: everybody deserves a chance to get vaccinated against COVID-19. We encourage our constituents to continue to strongly and vocally advocate for the most underserved populations, who have frequently found themselves deemed "essential workers" in this pandemic while they remain among the most at risk of illness.
